Goals

- Assist members of the ACCG in developing an effective collaborative engagement strategy and ACCG meeting process approach through a situational assessment
- Aid in the implementation of the Collaborative Engagement Strategy through ACCG convenings over the next 10 months, including helping the collaborative identify and resolve differences in order to reach agreement on topics where consensus has been difficult to achieve

Facilitation Services

Scope and Timeline



Step 1: Information Gathering/Situational Assessment

- Complete relevant background reading
- Conduct phone interviews with up to 20 entities. Note that these interviews may include individuals or small groups. (1 hour in length)
- Document discussions to understand issues, opportunities, evaluate assumptions and identify factors for success

Timeline: Complete interviews by December 18, 2018

Scope and Timeline



Step 2: Prepare Assessment Findings Report & Convene Workshop

Based on the outcomes of the neutral/confidential assessment interviews, prepare a report (in the form of a PowerPoint Presentation) and present at a findings workshop to:

- summarize the scope and relevant issues and concerns
- clarify and neutrally describe the range of perspectives
- describe collaborative process and framework improvements for greater effectiveness
- identify strategies, practices, policies, and collaboration skills

Timeline: Present findings to ACCG in late January 2019

Scope and Timeline



Step 3: Prepare Collaborative Engagement Strategy and Next Steps Brief

- Prepare a Collaborative Engagement Strategy and Next Steps Brief proposing a process design and collaborative engagement strategy for the ACCG.

Timeline: Complete by end of February 2019

Scope and Timeline



Step 4: Implement Collaborative Engagement Strategy

- Facilitate up to 11 meetings with ACCG
- Facilitate up to 16 meetings with the ACCG Planning Work Group
- Coordinate preparation for meetings with the Administration Work Group

Timeline: February-September 2019

Next Steps



Next Steps:

- Work with Admin Work Group to finalize interviewee list, questions, and related communications (by November 19)
- Send email invitations for participation in assessment interviews (before Thanksgiving)
- Schedule interviews (by end of November)
- Complete interviews (by third week of December)
- Analyze findings and prepare report (January)
- Convene findings workshop to report assessment findings to ACCG (end of January)
