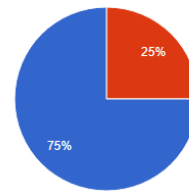
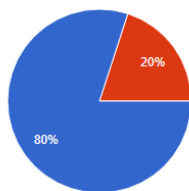
Participation in Hemlock Project Planning

- Participation was through field trips, planning meetings and full group meetings.

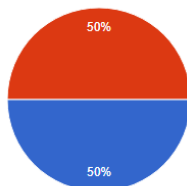
Collaborative Input/Concerns in Hemlock Project Planning

Are you satisfied with the amount of collaboration? Were concerns resolved with a proposed action?

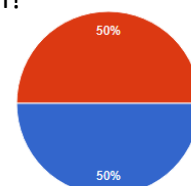

Were concerns resolved in an alternative?



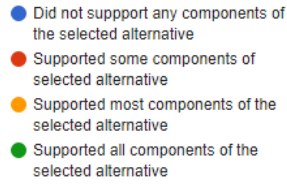
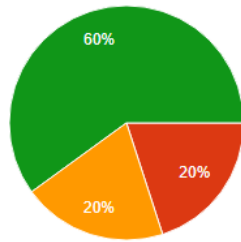
Was the alternative selected in the final project decision?

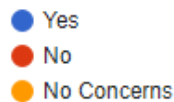
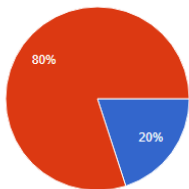
Did you support the selected alternative?



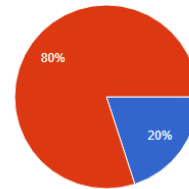
- Most felt they supported all or some of the components of the selected alternative

Did you participate in the objection process?



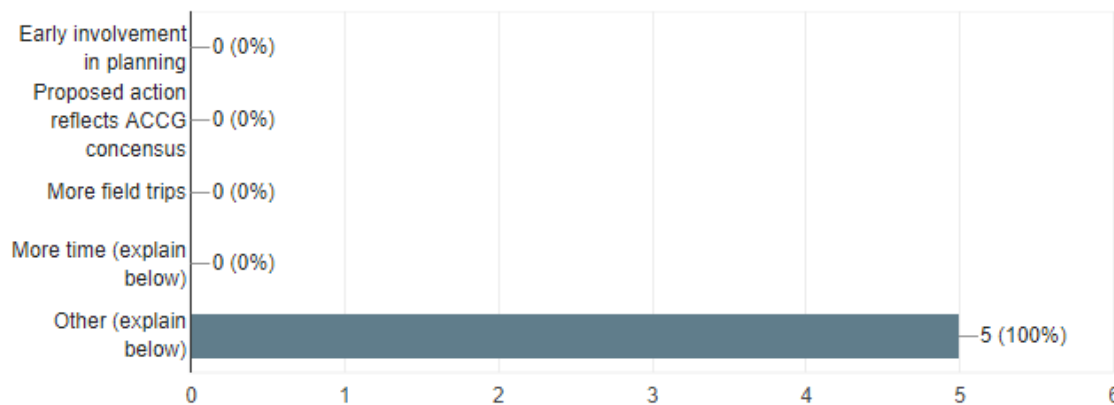
Did you submit a comment letter?
