- Power Fire Reforestation – June 19th

 - Get pre-treatment data on 3 units
 - Cover form, plot data form, photographs
 - Meet district office 8:00
 - Bring lunch, water, strong pants, boots
 - **Robin** will get Gwen and Reuben hard hat
 - Find a 4 person vehicle for everyone
 - Becky will have all field gear
 - **Becky** – check in with Marc/Jeff want to join – **done sent email**
 - If time allows check out some of controls in Panther – Becky will pick out pair of treated and untreated
 - Then discussion determine if want to sample controls
- Panther update
 - 23 plots completed at end of last week
 - This is last week of sampling expect to get an additional 10 plots
 - Focused on treatment plots – did not have time to sample controls plots, plus challenging to find good comparison controls and use pre-post

- Onion Meadows – September 10th-13th
 - Shana sent draft plot locations to Gwen
 - **Robin** – to confirm campground is reserved and free for Bear River group campground 10-13
 - Might have 1-2 additional volunteer forms to sign
 - Late September/October for conifer removal – could occur on weekends to get more folks
